IRRIGATION SYSTEM PERMIT APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

WHEN TO USE THIS PROCESS

Submit this application for:

- Commercial irrigation systems;
- Residential irrigation systems unless the option in the blue box is selected.

This application is *not* required for residential customers who would like for the City to install a separate irrigation meter and splice-in addition to the water meter.

- The fee for this is \$550, but the water bill will not include charges for sewer usage on the portion of the water that is used for irrigation.
- If you choose this option, call us at the number above. We will accept your payment and submit a work order to the Utilities Department for the installation, which will take about 6 weeks.
- Your irrigation contractor will connect the irrigation system to the new water meter box.
- No additional steps are required in terms of permitting or inspections.

APPLICATION AND INSPECTIONS PROCESS

- 1. Submit this application in PDF format through the Online Services website at www.cityofrockhill.com/onlineservices.
- 2. We will email you an invoice for the required fees, which will be paid online.
 - Fee schedule
- **3. Commercial customers only: Install the tap and meter box.** A City Infrastructure Inspector must witness the installation; call 803-448-9747 to schedule this.
- **4. Complete the work** on the irrigation system and connect it to the meter box.
 - The back flow device must be a testable double check or a reduced pressure principal valve.
- **5. Test the backflow preventer and submit the results** using our <u>Cross Connection Control Test Form</u> to the Planning and Development Department.
 - For commercial customers, if you need a meter to test the device, call us at 803-448-9747.
- **6. Schedule a final inspection** using our Online Application Portal. Our inspector will need access to the backflow prevention device.
- **7. Submit annual test results** to the Utilities Department employee listed on the Cross Connection Control Test Form.
