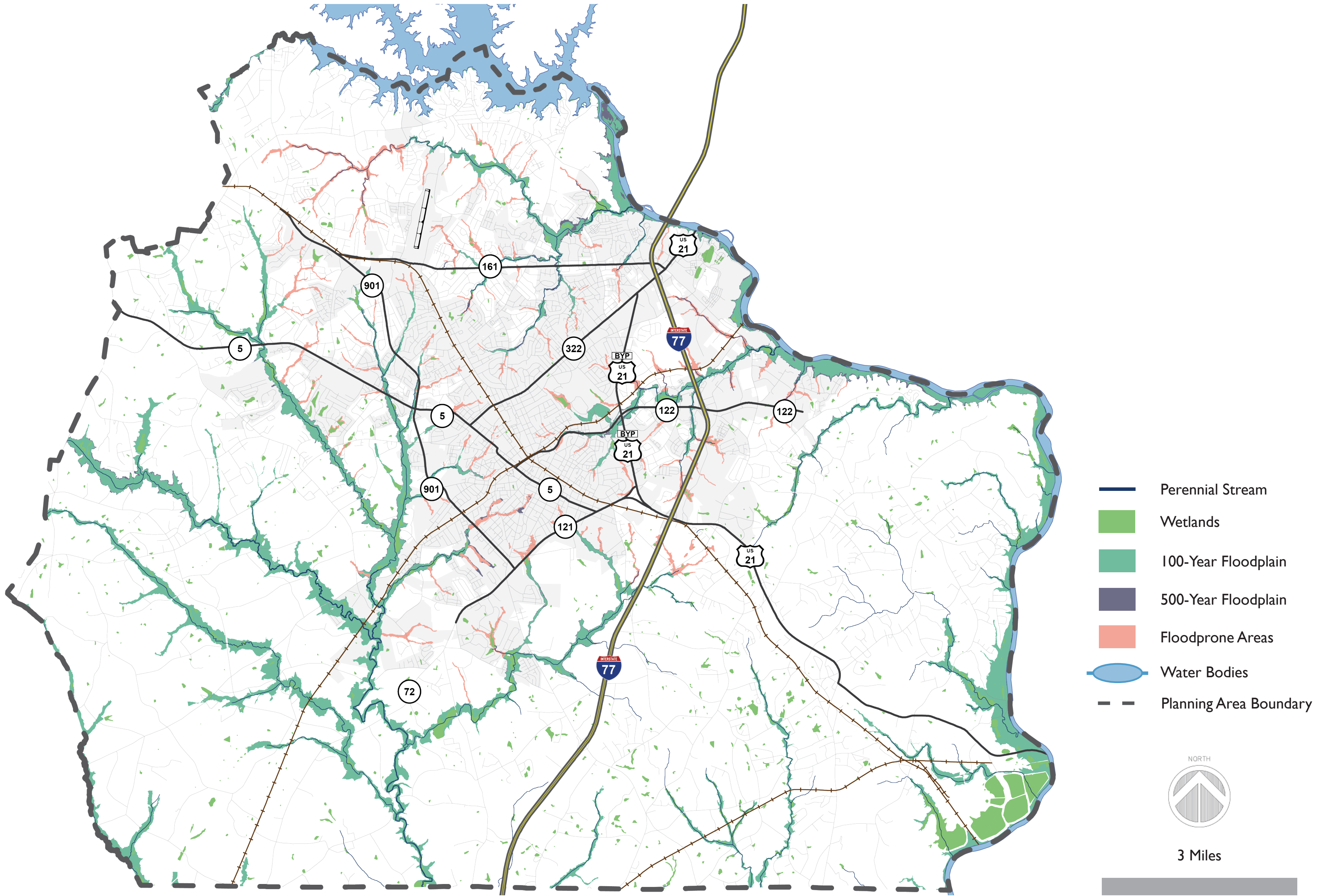

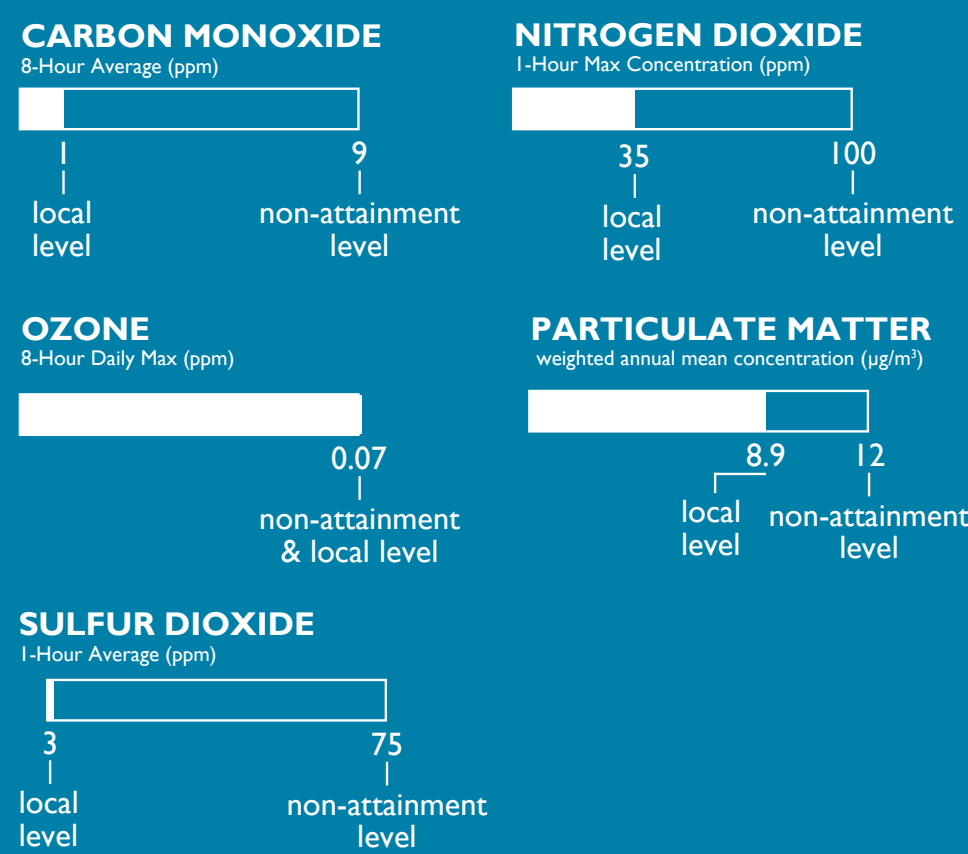
### State

According to the SC State Health Assessment, carbon monoxide, the most emitted pollutant in SC, has decreased from about 1,400 thousand tons in 2008 to 1,150 thousand tons in 2014.
