REGULAR SESSION - 5:30 P.M.

Council met in regular session with Mayor Gettys, Mayor Pro Tem Pender and Councilmembers Black, Jackson, Lindsay, Reno, and Sutton. Also present were City Manager David Vehaun, Deputy City Manager Jimmy Bagley, Deputy City Manager Steven Gibson, City Attorney Paul Dillingham, and Municipal Clerk Anne P. Harty. No members of the media were in attendance.

ORDINANCE PROVIDING EMERGENCY PROCEDURES FOR PUBLIC MEETINGS OF THE CITY OF ROCK HILL DURING THE CONTINUANCE OF SUCH EMERGENCY - Adopted

An emergency ordinance entitled AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING EMERGENCY PROCEDURES FOR PUBLIC MEETINGS OF THE CITY OF ROCK HILL DURING THE CONTINUANCE OF SUCH EMERGENCY was given first reading and adopted upon a motion by Councilmember Reno, which was duly seconded and unanimously approved.

This proposed Emergency Procedures Ordinance will enable the use of temporary electronic City Council meetings for the next sixty (60) days. The proposed action will supplement current City of Rock Hill COVID-19 practices already implemented which include certain emergency City government and service related protocols within our community. Under the current municipal code, emergency ordinances to meet public emergencies affecting life, health, safety or the property of the people may be adopted by the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the members of council present. An emergency ordinance is effective immediately upon its enactment without regard to any reading, public hearing or publication requirement or public notice requirement. The municipal code also states that emergency ordinances expire automatically as of the 61st day following the date of enactment. The City Manager and City Attorney recommended adoption of this Ordinance.

Upon a motion by Councilmember Reno, which was duly seconded and unanimously approved, the City Council approved the following eight consent agenda items with Mayor Gettys recusing from the eight item:
