I. Call to order

Angela Jordan called to order the regular meeting of the Stormwater Advisory Board at 5:30 p.m. on June 2, 2020 via the Public Works meeting room conference call. A motion to approve the minutes of the March 10, 2020 meeting was made by Terrence Nealy and seconded by Bill Taylor.

II. Meeting Summary

- Staff gave a status update on Masterplan Capital Improvement projects. Project #10-College Downs, construction has halted, working with engineer to update street design. #11-Cavendale Drive, city crews are currently working on the sewer. City negotiated with the contractor to do all hauling for the project to get to an agreeable project cost
- Staff gave an update on the Masterplan Neighborhood Projects. Project #8- College Ave., work in progress. The detention pond wall is 70% complete and curb and gutter work 80% complete. Project #19- Stanley/McGuirt, no change since last update. Project #21-Bristol Parkway, finished phases one and two, right-of-way agents will make an attempt to get easements needed to complete remaining phases. Project #35-Aiken Ave., crews able to complete work while school out. #52- Vernsdale Rd., continuing to monitor and close road when needed. Project #53-Berry St., met with SCDOT. DOT now wants the city to install an additional culvert downstream. Project #53- Sunset Park, no progress unable to acquire easements. Project #57-Flint Hill, Pennies project 30% drawing submitted to York County, York County in turn will deliver to the city to make sure all issues addressed. Construction anticipated to begin 2022.

- Staff talked about the rain events on May 28th and May 29th. 54 work orders were responded to and closed. Some work orders and customers referred to SCDOT and some require follow-up and/or addition action.
- In other business, the group discussed the effects of COVID-19 on the City of Rock Hill.
