OLD

BUSINESS: Strategic Plan Update

• PRT expects to be given new direction regarding the strategic plan during the City Council Retreat in January 2021. The next three-year plan will begin in July 2021.

Master Plan Update

- Connectivity: Tech Park Bridge #2 construction is in process.
- Maintenance & Infrastructure: Northside exterior painting bid is in reference stage. Rock Hill Tennis Center court resurfacing is under contract. Miracle Park sidewalks and building masonry are in process. Rock Hill Tennis Center storage building bid opening is December 8.
- Sports Tourism: Rock Hill PRT continues to be a major economic development tool for the City.
 November events included 4 outdoor and 6 indoor events. Basketball events will continue at
 the Sports and Event Center in December. The Battle of the Rock basketball tournament is in
 partnership with Visit York County.
- Partnerships: The new soccer partnership agreement goes to City Council on December 14.
 The proposed partner will run the recreational soccer leagues within standards mandated by City Council with input from the commission. Under the agreement, PRT may still work with other agencies for events. PRT keeps control of field use decisions and maintenance.
- The Emmett Scott Advisory Committee worked with Director Taylor to select picnic shelter and playground projects for the Rock Hill Parks Foundation funding grant. Clinton Connect will be approached regarding the McGirt Auditorium \$2.6 million project. Additional immediate small projects such as lighting and fence upgrades are either in process or completed.

NEW

BUSINESS: PRT Department Update

- Upon the retirement of Economic and Urban Development (EUD) Director Stephen Turner, PRT recently welcomed former EUD event staff Martin Lane and Sarah Key. They bring with them ChristmasVille and the Old Town Association (OTA) and associated events.
- PRT will review all aspects of events and work to more fully engage the OTA board.
