I. Call to order

II. Meeting Summary

Staff gave a status update on Masterplan Capital Improvement projects. Project #10-College Downs, 90% floodplain work completed. Started installing the concrete curb. #11-Cavendale Drive, contractor has completed all structures in the stream and most of the stream realignment. Contractor asked for 260 day extension and was granted 50 days. Contractor has yet to sign change order for contract extension. Project #62 & 74 Tradition Way & Alysia Ct flood study will be completed with Cavendale project. #13-Bryant Blvd., Ponds #1 & # 2 are complete, need to reseed. Pond #3 is under design. Project #15 & 16 Barber & Arch, hired McAdams to study area. Project #31 Pebble/Stoneybrook, working with engineer to get contract signed. Project #45, 46 & 73 Blackmon & Ebinport, Completed projects needs flood study to update Flood maps. #38 Dave Lyle Blvd, State gave us a one million dollar grant for study. Project #55 Red River Rd, Planning has been reviewing the plans with Pennies Project. Project #12 Riverview, Need final report from engineer.

• Staff gave an update on the Neighborhood Projects. Project #19 Stanley/McQuirt, Applied for grant to pay for materials. Project #35-Aiken/College Alley, Purchased pipe and waiting for boxes, also waiting for water and sewer. Project-#22 Whitner/Green, will be studied with CIP#15 & 16. Project #53 Berry Street, DOT

requiring us to do more work downstream. Project #54-Sunset Park, we are still trying to acquire properties. Project #57-Flint Hill, Completion date keeps moving further out possible 2024-2025. Project #78-83 Stream Study, Last winter, contractor still working on stream assessment of Wildcat & Dutchman creeks.

- Stormwater has 40 open workorders. Maintenance crew cleaned pipe on Nitghhawk, installed catch basin on Confederate, repaired sink hole on Copes Ct, & resealed pipe on Cedar st.
