## ROCK HILL LAKE PARK REGULATIONS

### WITHIN THE PARK

- Park Hours: Dawn to Dusk
- Entry into or remaining in the park after posted closing time is unlawful and a violation of City Code Section 21-1.
- Litter must be placed in receptacles.
- No fires or grills allowed.
- Fish only from fishing stations.
- No vehicles allowed outside of designated parking areas.
- No loitering, soliciting, or vending allowed.
- Camping is prohibited.
- No loud music or disorderly conduct.
- Firearms, weapons, explosives, and hunting are prohibited.
- Please refrain from smoking and the use of tobacco products.
- Alcoholic beverages and controlled substances are prohibited.
- No skateboards are allowed in the park.
- Swimming is prohibited at designated boating and fishing areas.
- Owners are responsible for their pets. All pets must be tightly controlled on a 3-foot leash. Owners are required to curb pets in grass areas only, clean any waste, and dispose of it in proper receptacles. **NO PETS IN BEACH OR SWIM AREAS.**
- Children must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- Use at your own risk. The City of Rock Hill is not responsible for accidents or injuries incurred while using the park or its facilities.

## **SWIM BEACH AREA**

- NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY, SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.
- Children should not swim or wade without adult supervision.
- Swim inside the yellow buoy line only.
- Glass containers, dogs, and pets are strictly prohibited on the beach and swim area.
- No fishing from the beach area.
- No ballgames or throwing objects in the beach area.
- Swim attire is required at all times. No nudity.
- Touching yellow buoy lines or steel piles is prohibited.
